Experience

Eduardo has worked in the insurance industry since 1986. Beginning in 1995, he researched and created managed care capabilities for an insurance company in Mexico. Through his leadership, this company was the first insurer to obtain the National Commission of Insurance (CNSF) authorization to operate comprehensive health plans in Mexico.

Previously, Eduardo was the general director of a subsidiary of ACTI, Inc. (BlueCross BlueShield of Arizona, BlueShield of California, and BlueCross BlueShield of Texas and Illinois). He helped design the entity's business plan and developed its work plan and financial projections, including the infrastructure required by the Specialized Health Insurance Institution (ISES). During his time as general director of this entity, which received the "BlueCross BlueShield de México" trademark, Eduardo was granted authorization by the National Commission of Insurance to operate a major medical insurance company.
